

## DxF Bi-Weekly Update

The Center for Data Insights and Innovation (CDII) is providing this bi-weekly communication to provide important updates and information on the Data Exchange Framework (DxF).

### **DxF Updates**

- CDII has developed a <u>Participant Directory User Guide</u> to explain the process of Participant exchange of Health and Social Services Information (HSSI).

### **DXF ROADMAP:**

- CDII is soliciting applications to 2025 Technical Advisory Subcommittee focus groups on key DxF Roadmap topics including identity management, consent management, social services information exchange, and event notification.

- All Round 3 Grantees (those awarded in 2024) MUST complete Milestone 1 by the March 31, 2025, Progress Report deadline.

### **QHIO PROGRAM:**

 The nine organizations in the QHIO program continue to demonstrate broad coverage for organizations and individuals across the state. Today, QHIOs collectively support exchange for over 60% of DxF Participants, managing over 60 million individual identities across the state.<sup>1</sup>  For information on the QHIO Program, please visit the <u>Qualified HIO Program section</u> of the CDII DxF webpage.

### **POLICIES AND PROCEDURES:**

- CDII has finalized and published an amendment to the Data Elements to Be
   Exchanged P&P as v1.2 following the close of public comment in early January 2025.
  - Version 1.2 of the P&P aligns the requirement for DxF Participants to exchange health and social services information in the US Core Data for Interoperability (USCDI) with the version required by the ASTP/ONC Health IT Certification Program effective beginning January 1, 2026.
  - Version 1.1 of the P&P remains published on the DxF website and v1.1, and its requirement to exchange according to USCDI v2, remains effective through December 31, 2025.
- CDII will be discussing potential amendments to the Technical Requirements for Exchange P&P to add technical requirements for Notifications for ADT Events as recommended to CDII by IAC and other advisory committees.
